Wedding Favors

Your wedding day is your special day but it is also a special day for your guests, loving friends and family who came to celebrate your happiness. Favors though not crucial, offer you a wonderful opportunity to thank them for traveling from near and far to share your day. Make your favors personal, thoughtful and appreciative. Give functional favors that will not be tossed but kept by your guests as meaningful mementos of your wedding. So, when working on your wedding budget, count favors in. Favors come in all shapes, sizes, colors and price tags. Long lasting, personalized favors are most popular because they will remind the recipients of your wedding long after the special day. You can personalize your favors in print or in writing, which can be done directly on the favors or on tags you attach to them. However, before you decide what to present to your guests, consult your budget. Wedding favors do not have to be expensive and can be given to each guest, each couple or each family attending. You may wish to have your favors multi-task. For example: Many favors such as picture frames can double as place card holder. Or have a centerpiece made of favors. You may have each marked with the name of the recipient be it an individual, a couple or a family. If you plan to give individual favors, you may consider making the favors given to the men different from those given women and from those given to children. This will add variety and fun. If you have a theme wedding, special colors etc, you may wish to have the favor represent or coordinate with the theme, color or... So, plan ahead! Consider the size of your guest list and your budget and devote time to research until you find the perfect wedding favors. Whether pricy or not, make the presentation of your wedding favors beautiful and tasteful and if possible personal. Your guests will appreciate your thoughtfulness. Want to make your favors conversation pieces? Get creative and find un-traditional ways to display them. Hang the wedding favors on chairs, placards, or the ornamental trees that decorate your reception site. If you have an outdoor wedding, the trees will work well and the favors will add to their décor. You may also place the favors in baskets either at the door, on each table or assign favor ambassadors to present a favor to each wedding guest.

Plan to have extra favors available for 'Just in Case' situations and to send to friends and family who were unable to attend your wedding.
